Agenda: Conduct of BOS meeting for all the Departments and Preparation for SSR		

The meeting started with invocation by Mr. Abdul Lathif, COE.

Dr. S. Basheer Ahmed, congratulated Dr. Anvar Sadhath and all the Core committee members in his presidential address for their inexorable efforts to submit AQAR for 2018 - 19 and 2019 - 2020 and for the initiatives taken up for SSR submission.

Dr. Kamal Nasir suggested forming separate committees for i) Data Coordination and the ii) SSR Preparation.
