Discussion

The Dean of Research read out the minutes of the previous meeting and secured the approval of the house for the same after discussion.

While introducing the issues to be discussed in the meeting, the Dean of Research opined that there is a growing need for creating awareness among the students and research scholars on the ethical practices, particularly in the post-covid scenario.

The Principal, Dr. S. Basheer Ahamed concurred with the views of the Dean of Research and observed that the discussions on ethical practices in research can also be extended to addressing similar issues in the Undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.

Dean of Research observed that steps are to be taken to create awareness on research ethics among students. He opined that a meeting of the research supervisors can be convened to discuss the matter, and they may be entrusted with the responsibility of sensitising students on the ethical concerns.

Dr Anvar Sadhath, Director of IQAC highlighted the necessity to implement the research ethics course meaningfully for all Ph.D. scholars. He felt that the college may develop separate course materials taking into account the ethics to be followed while pursuing research in different disciplines.
