Discussion

The convenor presented the minutes of the previous meeting and action taken report and the same was approved by the house after a brief discussion.

The Dean of Research read out the minutes of the previous meeting and secured the approval of the house for the same after discussion.

The Director of IQAC, Dr Anvar Sadhath, brought to the notice of the house the implementation challenges of the revised research policy. He informed the house that owing to the pandemic situation many proposals in the research policy are yet to be implemented. However, he lauded the efforts of the Dean of Research towards inviting applications for the seed grant.

Dr. Abdul Raheem suggested conducting open defence presentation for selecting beneficiaries for the research grant.

Dr. Kalilur Rahman, Associate Professor of Chemistry, opined that the applicants for seed grant may make presentations in front of the screening committee. He also observed that the outcome of the project work need to be reemphasised, because, only then the institution and the country as a whole will get benefitted by the amount of money spent on seed grant.

Resolutions Passed

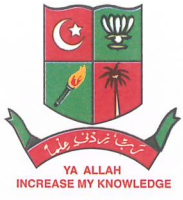
The meeting resolved to hold presentations to select the candidates for the seed grant for the academic year – 2020-21.




