# ABOUT US

The New College is a Government- Aided Muslim minority College affiliated to the University of Madras. It was founded by the Muslim Educational Association of Southern India (MEASI). Since its inception in 1951 with about 200 intermediate course students, The New College has rigorously upheld its commitment to providing quality Higher Education to the deserving students, especially from weaker sections of the society. The college is currently run by a Managing Committee of the MEASI under the Chairmanship of Janab. Imtiaz Pasha.

On our beautiful campus on Peters Road, Royapettah, Chennai, more than 6000 students pursue their intellectual passion through 56 academic programmes. The New College campus also houses three other institutions run by its parent body viz., MEASI Academy of Architecture, MEASI Institute of Management and MEASI Institute of Information Technology.

Although the college and its allied institutions were established to educationally empower students belonging to the Muslim community in Tamil Nadu, the college has students and teachers from different communities and almost all parts of India. We have a few students from abroad as well. There is a provision for nearly 500 students to reside in the College Hostel. The parent body of the college uses a major share of income every year to give scholarships to students from economically less privileged families.

## NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a youth-centric programme launched in 1969 by the Government of India, and operated under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunity to the student youth of India to take part in various government led and other community service activities and programmes. The motto of the scheme is “Education through Community Service.” First and Second year UG Students are eligible for enrolment in NSS. The New College has four units of NSS with 100 students per unit. The NSS activities of the college are coordinated by four Programme Officers.

The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are :

1. Understand the community in which they work
2. Understand themselves in relation to their community
3. Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem-solving
4. Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility
5. Utilise their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems
6. Develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities
7. Gain skills in mobilising community participation
8. Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes
9. Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters, and
10. Practise national integration and social harmony



## NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)

The college provides training to students in NCC under the

1) Infantry Wing and 2) Armoured Squadron

Enrolment of cadets is made soon after admission to the college. Students are engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The motto of the NCC is “Unity & Discipline.” Smart and capable cadets are entitled to selection for adventure courses, all India advance leadership camps, summer training camps of other states, training in the Himalayan mountaineering institute, republic day parade contingent at New Delhi, etc. Outstanding cadets are entitled to selection for going abroad under a youth exchange programme.





# HOSTEL

Boys enrolled in the college have access to hostel accommodations. The New College Hostel offers comfortable, spacious, and well-furnished rooms. The hostel provides a complimentary laundry service and serves hygienically prepared meals along with R.O. water. An environment conducive to studying is maintained for students residing in the hostel. A separate section is earmarked in the hostel for the PG students.

Students who want accommodation in the hostel should obtain the necessary application form from the hostel office and apply after getting admission in the college.

# CAREER GUIDANCE & PLACEMENT CELL

The Career Guidance and Placement Cell (CGPC) of the college offers training the students in employability skills and arranges various on-campus, off-campus and online placement drives for the outgoing students. Students who wish to attend campus placement drives are required to register either directly by visiting the Placement cell office or by using the online registration link shared through the Department. The cell also arranges part time jobs for students who are compelled to earn while they learn. Efforts are also taken by the Cell to promote internships among the students.

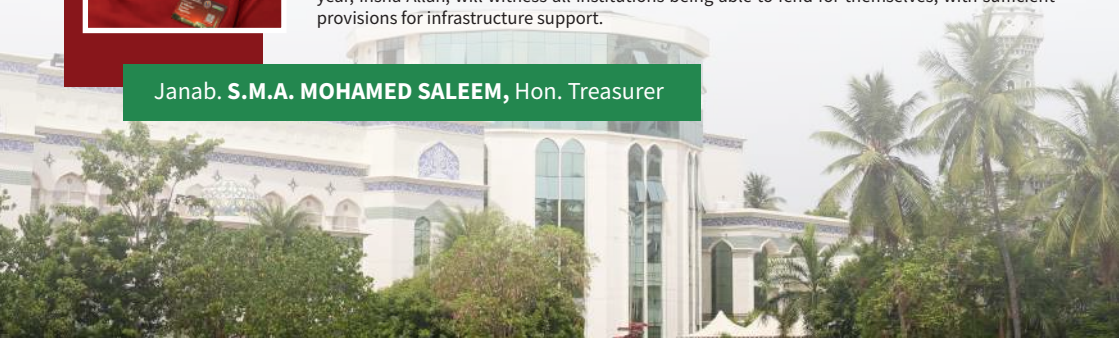

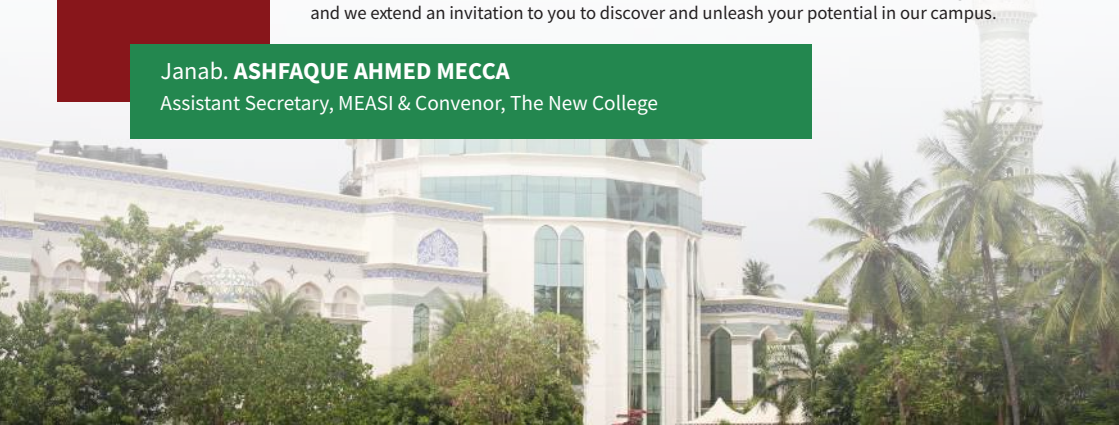
